FAQ for Racers on the running of the Loudon Classic Weekend. 6.1.2025

This document is intended to answer some questions regarding the Loudon Classic Weekend.

1. What do I need to get into the track for the weekend? You will need a NEMRR armband. You can get that by a) adding it to your race entry (and it will be at the NEMRR window for you) or b) you can buy one at the NEMRR on site window. The NEMRR onsite window will not be in its usual place but at the



ticket trailer (T) here:

There is no parking in S2 and S3 lots due to vendors so you will have to drive past the infield tunnel and park up behind T6 on the left side in the S4 lot and walk down. There is a limit of two cars per racer allowed in the infield for which you will receive a Sticker That Must Be Applied To The Front Left Side Of Your Windshield In Order To Enter The Tunnel. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Hours of operation will be Thursday 7am-10pm, Friday 6am to 10pm, Saturday 7am to 5pm and Sunday 7am to 3pm.

As a reminder All persons on the property MUST sign the event release waiver before they will be allowed into the infield area or Racetrack viewing area and must wear their armbands at ALL times. If you do not have an arm band, you will be escorted from the property.


- 2. What do I need to get my family and friends into the track for the weekend? You will need a NEMRR armband. You can get that by **a**) adding up to 10 additional armbands to your pre-registration entry at a fee of \$30 (and they will also be at the window and can be picked up by the individual(s) once they sign the waiver) or **b**) you can buy one at the NEMRR onsite window for \$40. You cannot pick up the additional armbands yourself as the person has to sign the WAIVER in person. NEMRR is not responsible for controlling who redeems your extra armbands nor are we responsible for replacing lost, stolen, or broken armbands.
- 3. What about Camping? Camping is managed by NHMS. If you have a garage camping pass for the season you don't need any additional paperwork. If you **do not** you need a camping pass issued by NHMS for the weekend. If the infield fills up, you may expect that you will be outside the infield in one of the back lots. Contact Mary at NHMS 603-513-5734 for camping.

- 4. What about access to the hot pit? Regular NEMRR rules DO NOT APPLY. You will need a specific NEMRR PIT ACCESS armband that is given to the racer and crew as well as appropriate clothing (closed shoes, long pants, and clothing not red in color) and no one under 18 (unless an approved racer). Each racer racing this weekend will be allowed up to 6 named individuals on the hot pit DURING THEIR PRACTICE, QUALIFYING OR RACE ONLY. These are named people that must be supplied to NEMRR in advance. An email from admin will give you the option to get them to NEMRR before the event, but you can come into registration and supply them when registration is open. To get an armband each person will have to sign an additional waiver.
- 5. What if I did not pre-register? You will need to get an armband to get into the infield (during the posted hours) and then go to registration (during the posted hours) to register to race. It is probable that this is likely to suck in terms of standing in multiple lines.
- 6. When can I get into the Track? Access for the NEMRR event will start on Thursday at 5pm. If you are there for any of the other events that week then you need to check with them about credentials and hours of access. If you are in the infield for another earlier event starting at 7pm on Thursday, if you do not have a NEMRR armband for each individual and a NHMS camping pass for any campers for the weekend you will be escorted off the property.
- 7. Are there any restrictions on access with my NEMRR armband? You have full access per a normal NEMRR weekend to the infield and grandstands for all 3 days except: hot pit access (see above #4), Granite Ledge and the VIP seating in Turn 1 which all require specific armbands.
- 8. Garage/Hot pit operations during Saturday. The hot pit and garage traffic flow will have several additional issues on Saturday. First Motorcycles will NOT be allowed back in and reentry from the Garage area during Saturday Qualifying and the Race. For safety this means that individuals that cross the hot pit before the start of these events will have to stay on the track side of the hot pit until that specific event is completed or there is a red flag delay. Second the area from the Starters Tower for 200 feet down the track is reserved solely for people making signals to their rider and limited to one per rider. This will be marked by a start stop set of cones. Third, motorcycles leaving qualifying and the top bikes in the race may be directed to a technical inspection area or the awards area and this may be COUNTER to the normal traffic flow in front of the north garages.
- 9. What about Alcohol? There will be no consumption of alcohol by any person until after the track goes "cold" at the end of the race day in the infield. The only exception to this rule is if NHMS explicitly provides a sectioned off exclusive drinking area for the sale and/or consumption by spectators only. UNKOWN currently if NHMS intends this.
- 10. What am I responsible for before leaving NHMS? You are responsible for cleaning up after yourself and all your crew/guests. All trash shall be picked up and disposed of properly. Absolutely NO OIL, GAS CANS OR TIRES CAN BE LEFT ON PROPERTY. FINES WILL BE INCURRED.

- 11. Are campfires allowed? Yes, only in self-contained fire pits. NO ASHES OR PARTIALLY BURNED WOOD OR COALS CAN BE DISPOSED OF IN DUMPSTERS AT ANY TIME.
- 12. Are pets allowed? Yes, but they must be on a leash and or always secured. You are responsible for always cleaning up after your pet. THE PENALTY FOR NOT DOING WILL BE FINES INCURRED.
- 13. What is the speed limit in the infield? 15 MPH

Please abide by all signs throughout property, this will be strictly enforced.
